Film Production Group Feedback:

You submitted a professionally-presented, body of coursework that shows a good understanding of the requirements of the module.

Your film evidenced good understanding of cinematography, sound, editing, mise-en-scene and performance which all added to the creative realisation of your film. Your narrative was original and well considered in relation to the assignment. You also embedded appropriate conventions to ensure the genre and representations within the film were sound and coherent with the desired production outcomes.

Suggested areas for improvement – Using a brick wall as the backdrop to the setting for the main conversation was a creative decision which was not explained within the written reflection. You could have added further depth to the characters backstory (creative mise-en-scene) within the choice of location for shooting this key scene. Some scenes (walking into the property / kitchen scene) could have benefited from further consideration of framing and choice of camera angles and focus as they appeared less planned out that the main conversation scene. Although you worked well within the time constraints of the production, did you consider including some flash-back cutaways to add further detail which could help viewer understanding of back story and motivation. These are issues which could have been discussed in your written reflections.

Key strengths – The performance from both actors was believable and engaging. Rich Keeble added a high level of authenticity within his performance as 'David'. Well done for sourcing these actors. Use of shot reverse shot and framing choices during the conversation scene added well to the pace and tension within the dialogue. Considered use of atmospheric non-diegetic sound fx helped build tension within the production.
